

FROM LAND NORTHWARD TO LAND SOUTHWARD WALK THE POSSIBLE LANDS OF THE BofM

14 DAYS /13NIGHTS

DAY 01- ARRIVAL TRANSFER

Welcome at the Mexico City "Benito Juarez" international airport, transfer to the hotel of your choice and accommodation.

DAY 02 CITY TOUR // ANTHROPOLOGY

In the morning we will start our tour visiting the national palace, the constitution square (the central plaza or "zocalo") and the Metropolitan Cathedral as well as some of the main avenues; like Madero street and, historical buildings like post office building, Palacio de Bellas Artes, Reforma avenue with the angel of Independence, in addition to the "pink zone" (zona rosa) and visit Revolution monument, , we shall later visit Chapultepec park and we will visit the anthropology museum the museum's collections include the most important cultures of Mexico, If Mesoamerica is really the lands of the Book of Mormon as most scholars claim, then the museum is by far the best place to learn about the possible relationship between Mesoamerica and the Book of Mormon, in this visit it is possible to find the greatest number of coincidences cultural, social, military, political and religious with the Book of Mormon. return to the hotel.

DAY 3 TEOTIHUACAN PYRAMIDS // ACOLMAN

In the morning we shall start our tour visiting the famous archaeological site of Teotihuacan, enigmatic place full of information that could have a clear connection with BofM where we shall see the monumental Pyramids of the Sun and The Moon, the temple of Quetzalpapalotl, the citadel and the avenue of the dead; all this with an Ids insight, Then we will visit the convent of Acolman, a place that tradition tells us was the place where the Augustinian monks invented the piñata as a Christian symbol. return to the hotel.

DAY 04 MEXICO / PUEBLA

Breakfast Departure to Puebla We shall start our visit in Santa Maria Tonanzintla one of the greatest church in Mexico; from there we shall continue to the archaeological site of Cholula, where the biggest pyramid in the world is to be found and we shall visit it along tunnels which furrow the inside of the pyramid until they reach the great Sanctuary of Cholula that is known as the city of the 365 churches since it has one for each day of the year; later, we shall carry on to the colonial city of Puebla; The majority of whose buildings are decorated with tiles and beautifully sculpted freestone; we shall also see its majestic Cathedral, The main Square, The Chapel of the Rosary in the Santo Domingo temple, considered the eighth wonder of the art world. The city of Puebla has recently been named as a heritage of humanity place by "Unesco". Accommodation.



DAY 05-PUEBLA- OAXACA – MONTE ALBAN – MITLA – TULE

Breakfast. In the morning we travel to Oaxaca and visit Monte Alban, an important archaeological zone where we will find important remains of Olmeca, Zapoteca and Mixteca cultures: the Main Square, the Observatory, Tomb # 7, the Stones of the Dancers. We will continue to Mitla, whose buildings are decorated with symbolic mosaics. In route we are going to meet the Tule Tree, one of the biggest living beings in the world. Return to Oaxaca City and accommodation.

DAY 06-OAXACA CITY TOUR

At the time indicated we shall visit the interesting colonial city; the church and former convent of Santo Domingo, the cathedral and the fountain of the seven regions etc. free noon for your own activities.

DAY 07- OAXACA / SUMIDERO / SAN CRISTÓBAL DE LAS CASAS

Breakfast. Early in the morning, departure to Tuxtla Gutierrez, capital city of the State of Chiapas, enjoying the landscapes of the southern mountains. Boat ride by Sumidero Canyon, with 1,000 meters in its highest point. We pass by Chiapa de Corzo, where we can admire its Mudejar style fountain. Continue to San Cristobal. **Dinner** and accommodation.

DAY 08- SAN CRISTÓBAL DE LAS CASAS INDIAN TOWNS

Breakfast. Visit to San Juan Chamula and Zinacantán, typical Indian towns, to see some archaic rites pagan-religious that the people keep. Free afternoon to visit this beautiful city: the Market, Cathedral, Santo Domingo church. Accomodation.

DAY 09- SAN CRISTÓBAL DE LAS CASAS — AGUA AZUL - PALENQUE.

Breakfast. Continuation to Agua Azul Falls, to admire their turquoise-colored waters. After a short stop at Misol-Há, another beautiful waterfall, we will continue to Palenque. **Dinner** and accommodation.

DAY 10- PALENQUE - CAMPECHE

Breakfast. Visit to Palenque, one of the most important Mayan archaeological sites, both historic and aesthetically. Inside the Temple of the Inscriptions, it was found the King Pakal's Tomb and its gravestone, beautifully engraved in relief. Departure to Campeche. **Dinner.** Accommodation.



DAY 11- CAMPECHE – UXMAL - MERIDA

Breakfast. Panoramic city tour and departure to Uxmal. Visit of this archaeological site and its wonders: The Guesser Pyramid, the Nun's Square, Governor's Palace, and the Ballgame Court. **Lunch** and continuation to Merida, "the White City" to take a panoramic city tour: Montejo Avenue, the monument to Motherland, the Main Square. Accommodation.

DAY 12- MERIDA – CHICHEN-ITZA - CANCUN

Breakfast. Departure to Chichén Itzá, the most known Mayan ruins in Mexico. We'll visit the pyramid "The Castle", the Ballgame Court, the Observatory, the One Thousand Columns Square, Jaguars' Temple, the Sacred Well (cenote). **Lunch**. Continuation to Cancun; in route, visit to one Well. Arrival and accommodation.

DAY 13- CANCUN

Breakfast. Free day for your own activities.

DAY 14- CANCUN

Breakfast. At a set time pick up and transfer hotel / airport to take your flight back home.
